

PROVERBS on YOU and YOUR MORALITY

Prov. 5:1-14 (re: fornication); 5:15-23 (re: adultery)

[Prov. 5:8 Keep your way far from her, and do not go near the door of her house,]

Prov. 6:24-35 (re:fornication and adultery)

[Prov. 6:27 Can a man take fire in his bosom, and his clothes not be burned?]

Prov. Chapter 7 (re: fornication and adultery)

[Prov. 7:7 And I saw among the naive, I discerned among the youths, a young man lacking sense,]

Prov. 9: 13-18 (re: the adulterous woman)

[Prov. 9:16 “Whoever is naive, let him turn in here,” And to him who lacks understanding she says]

Prov. 14:30 A tranquil heart is life to the body, but passion is rotteness to the bones.

Prov. 22:14 The mouth of an adulteress is a deep pit; He who is cursed of the Lord will fall into it.

Prov. 23:26-28 Give me your heart, my son, and let your eyes delight in my ways. For a harlot is a deep pit, and an adulterous woman is a narrow well. Surely she lurks as a robber, and increases the faithless among men.

Prov. 29:3 A man who loves wisdom makes his father glad, but he who keeps company with harlots wastes his wealth.

Prov. 30:20 This is the way of an adulterous woman: She eats and wipes her mouth, And says, “I have done no wrong.”
